Caritas Sri Lanka has made a change to incorporate opportunities and to broad base the "Spirit of Charity" amongst sources and beyond the customary Caritas confederation.

Funding projects is a vital role in carrying out project activities. Charitable funding is scarce vis a vis availability of commercial funding.

Charity sourcing are mostly short term and a few in the medium term .However Serving Humanity is an infinite process

Caritas Sri Lanka projects have been a success story due to its following of Gospel values and Leadership in serving humanity irrespective of caste creed or race. The projects in the past were mainly built along providing Food Clothing and Shelter during and following emergencies.

Caritas Sri Lanka in its due course of activities have obtained aid and donations in the form of cash and equipment or in any other form and utilize same in implementing projects and thereafter .This activity would be continuous and constant search and vigilance for opportunities are sought.

A Lenten programme is carried out by caritas dioceses. Plans are being formulated to Revisit the convention activities and make necessary changes to improve on same to formulate a policy programme as a National Activity.

CHARITY IS CARING TO SHARE FOR HUMANITY.

In broad basing opportunities Caritas has taken several steps in the new direction.

Setting up of an Unit to focus on this activity. This unit will be required to research constantly, using technology to reach all global sources on new opportunities and submit comprehensive project proposals .Follow up of same should be an activity developed as these projects would be "OPEN ENDED".

The Corporate Sector is another identified area for submission of project proposals and promote to work jointly alongside the Corporate Social Responsibility Programmes carried out by this sector. The expertise, experience and economics would add as new learning experiences for the caritas staff.

A Specific Fund raising programme will also form part and parcel of the nucleus of funding and is in its planning stage.

Caritas Sri Lanka has made encouraging progress in reducing poverty and building bridges of reconciliation ,but pockets of severe poverty remain and future prosperity will depend on addressing an inclusive economy, such as sustenance programme's.

Caritas Sri Lanka would carry out the above proposals to sustaining progress and towards improving substance to alleviate poverty and to boost shared prosperity.
